On 5 and 6 March 2019, took place in Kaunas (Lithuania) the Kickoff Meeting of "SELAM—Learning Self Awareness & Self Management to eliminate Bullying and create Peer Support Scheme in the Immigrant concentrated Schools" project, funded by Erasmus+ KA2 Program (Strategic Partnerships Strategic partnerships for school education), in which were presented the project aims, activities and partners.

The objective of the project is to find solutions to effectively reduce "peer bullying" and to support migrant students' integration within the classroom.

The main purpose of SELAM project is to enhance new comers' sense of belonging and contribute to the reduction of peer victimization and bullying, by addressing these issues through innovative approaches, such as digital storytelling.
